FREEDOM OF INFORMATION – DECISION NOTICE

FOI Reference Number: 18853

I refer to your email of 12 November requesting information in respect of primary care network funding.

I can confirm on behalf of Great Yarmouth and Waveney, North Norfolk, South Norfolk, West Norfolk and Norwich CCGs and in accordance with S.1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) that we do hold some of the information that you have requested. A response to each element of your request is detailed below:

- 1. Details of all Primary Care Networks (PCN) successfully awarded funding – 1. I'm looking for successful applications for the Primary Care at Scale fund/Primary Care Network Development Fund that was offered out by CCGs during the summer in a number of waves. The precise details are the names of the Primary Care Networks that asked for, and were successful, in their funding applications.*
- 2. Details of any PCNs that were unsuccessful in their applications – 2. same as one, but unsuccessful*
- 3. A list of the practices within those networks*
- 4. Name(s) of the PCN lead responsible officer/chief executive/clinical lead/managing partner – the name of the person who represents the network.*
- 5. Contact details for the PCNs*

Responses for all five CCGs

1 – The CCGs are currently bidding for central funding for PCNs but have not heard of the outcome of this bid as of yet. No one locally has been awarded funding for this over the summer period.

2 - Unable to determine who were unsuccessful in their application, as we have not heard the outcome of this bid as of yet.
