WN-2017-00003 – Total Planned Spend by the CCG on General Practice Services

1. Total planned spending by the CCG on general practice services for 2017/18, and a breakdown of how this figure is made up.

NHS West Norfolk CCG is planning to spend £28m for 2017/18 which support both PMS and GMS practices. These costs relate to both List Size activity (c.£18m), Premises costs (£3m) and other GP services which include Enhanced Services and the Quality Outcome Framework (QOF) (c.£7m).

2. Total spending by the CCG on general practice services in 2016/17, and a breakdown of how this figure is made up.

The CCG was not authorised for delegated commissioning so no costs related to direct practice expenditure were incurred. These were the responsibility of NHS England.
