I would like to make a freedom of information request for the number of times, since April 2013 to September 2014, that more than 50% of the members of the CCG governing body meeting have been required to withdraw from a meeting or part of it, owing to the arrangements agreed for the management of conflicts of interests or potential conflicts of interests?
